

Specially Designated Global Terrorist (SDGT) and Foreign Terrorist Organization (FTO)

The US State Department has designated May 16, 2018:

- "The Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant (ISIL) in the Great Sahara" as the Specially Designated Global Terrorist (SDGT) under Executive Order No. 13224,
- The Islamic State of Iraq and the Levant (ISIL) in the Great Sahara as a Foreign Terrorist Organization (FTO) under section 219 of the Immigration and Nationality Act,
- Adnan Abu Walid Al-Sahrawi as Specially Designated Global Terrorist (SDGT) under Article 1 (b) of Executive Decree 13224.

Following this decision, the United States Government intends to take the necessary measures to freeze the assets of this group and individual and to prohibit its nationals (individuals and legal entities) to carry out any transaction with this group or individual or their knowingly provide material support or resources.

The US State Department believes that this designation is decided in accordance with United Nations Security Council Resolutions 1373 and 2253.

To this end, it invites our country to take similar measures against them, to share any information concerning the actions undertaken and the activities or assets of this group and this individual in Algeria.
